## BARNS & STABLES NEEDED

If you have a rodent problem,  
we have the *purrfect* solution:

A reliable feline companion  
that will work for food and board.

At Worcester Animal Rescue League, we pursue every avenue to find a home for our animals. Occasionally we get cats that are very skittish around people or cats that are very tame but aren't suited for indoor home life. Cats like these usually enjoy life as a barn cat. They thrive in country areas where they can put their natural hunting abilities to good use.

For an adoption fee of just \$25, you'll get a dependable feline worker that has been spayed or neutered. (It can't produce dozens of kittens.) WARL also vaccinates the cats for rabies and distemper.

In return for their reliable service to your farm, barn cats need a safe, sanitary, comfortable shelter protected from the elements and adequately warm in the winter. They also need fresh food and clean water daily. Even a cat that's a great mouser needs the vitamins and minerals found in manufactured cat food.



Please give the cat appropriate health and veterinary care for injury or illness including flea treatments, deworming and updated vaccinations. Adding healthy years to your cat's life will give the cat added years of hunting experience and enjoyable companionship for you.

To help these cats adjust to their home, we recommend confining them to a barn or shed for 2 to 4 weeks. When the cats feel secure that they have a warm place to sleep and food every day, you can let them out to rid your farm of nesting rodents.
